## City of Fortuna APPLICATION FOR APPOINTMENT TO CITY BOARD/COMMISSION

#### **Planning Commission**

Purpose: To oversee the development of the General Plan, formation and administration of the

zoning map and ordinance, and review of development applications. Commission reviews and makes decisions on a variety of land use applications, including conditional

use permits, design review, subdivisions, and rezoning.

Meetings: The Commission meets twice a month, on the second and fourth Tuesday of each

month at 6:00pm at City Hall in the Council Chambers. Meetings typically last 1 to 2 hours. Meeting Preparation consists of reviewing the packet that is delivered on the Thursday or Friday prior to the Tuesday meeting, which includes a description of the project, site plans, a discussion of the project's conformance with the City's codes and compatibility with the neighborhood, and a recommendation by City staff to approve

or deny the project.

Terms: The Commissioners serve staggered four year terms.

Compensation: Planning Commissioners receive \$30 for each meeting attended.

#### **Historical Commission**

Purpose: To preserve the Northwestern Pacific Depot Building and to administer the operation

of the Museum which will provide reminders of the past eras, events, and person

important to the City of Fortuna.

Meetings: The Commission meets bi-monthly on the second Wednesday of every other month at

6:00pm at the Depot Museum.

Terms: The Commissioners serve staggered three year terms.

### **Parks and Recreation Commission**

Purpose: To serve in an advisory capacity to the City Council, City Manager, and the City Staff in

all matters pertaining to public Parks and Recreation.

Meetings: The Commission meets bi-monthly on the second Monday of every other month at

6:00pm at Rohner Park.

Terms: The Commissioners serve staggered three year terms.

#### **Measure E Oversight Committee**

Purpose: To assist the City Council in taking public input and review staff recommendations on the

expenditure of funds derived from the local sale tax imposed pursuant to Measure E.

Meetings: Third month of each quarter (March, September, & December), plus January on the third

Wednesday and the first Tuesday in April of the chosen month at 5:30pm at City Hall.

Terms: Two (2) members at two (2) years, three (3) members at three (3) years, and two (2)

members at four (4) years.
